



Limited Warranty on RapidFlow™ Gutter Drainage Protection

Introduction

Thank you for your recent purchase of RapidFlow™ Gutter Drainage Protection manufactured by Owens Corning Roofing & Asphalt, LLC ("Owens Corning"). We believe we manufacture the highest quality roofing products and systems available anywhere, and that is why we stand behind them with one of the best warranties in the industry. We have attempted to write this warranty in clear, plain-English terms, including the limitations and restrictions, so you will fully understand the warranty we are making to you. Who Is Covered

If you live in the United States or Canada and you are the original consumer purchaser, (i.e., the homeowner, not the installer or contractor), you are entitled to the benefits of this warranty.

Transferability of This Warranty

This warranty is personal to you and may not be transferred to any subsequent purchaser of your home.

How Long Are You Covered

This warranty remains in effect for a period of five (5) years following installation of your Owens Corning *RapidFlow* Gutter Drainage Protection.

What Is Covered

When your Owens Corning *RapidFlow* Gutter Drainage Protection is installed correctly and in the manner specified by Owens Corning and under normal leaf and debris conditions, we warrant that it will keep gutters from becoming clogged as a result of the interior of the gutter or downspouts filling with debris such as leaves, twigs, needles or seeds for a period of five (5) years and that it will withstand winds up to 110 MPH.

What Is Not Covered

This warranty does not cover:

1. Acts of God, such as hailstorms and winds in excess of 110 MPH;
2. Improper or faulty installation. Installation must have been performed in accordance with our written installation instructions;
3. Distortion or warping caused by exposure to excessive heat sources (i.e., barbecue grills) or exposure to unusual or excessive reflective heat sources (i.e., window reflection);
4. Any cost or expense incurred to clear any blockage or obstruction determined to be below grade;
5. Deterioration due to air pollution;
6. Changes in surface color resulting from fading, staining or chalking. Exposure to the elements may cause these changes over time;
7. Accidental damage, including any damage caused by objects (i.e., tree branches) falling on your roof;
8. Fire;
9. Structure settlement;
10. Misuse, abuse or vandalism;
11. Airborne stains, mold and mildew accumulation;
12. Any costs incurred by you that Owens Corning does not authorize in advance.

What Is Your Remedy

If, during the term of this warranty, your *RapidFlow* Gutter Drainage Protection fails to perform as warranted herein, we will pay you the cost (excluding labor), as reasonably determined by Owens Corning, to clean or replace the product, or provide a cash refund equal to replacement material cost.

How to Make a Claim

To make a claim under this warranty, you need to do so within thirty (30) days after you discover the problem. Just call us at 1-800-ROOFING or send us a letter addressed to Owens Corning, Customer Response Center, One Owens Corning Parkway, Toledo,

Ohio 43659. Explain the problem and include proof of purchase and the date your *RapidFlow* Gutter Drainage Protection was installed. Shortly after we receive your communication, we will contact you regarding your claim and will walk you through the entire process. To fully evaluate your claim, we may ask you to provide, at your expense, pictures of your gutters.
